

ECTS-Points at the Department of Philosophy

The following information should help you to finalize your Learning Agreement. It specifies the rules for earning credit points for incoming Erasmus students at our department.

Successful participation in a seminar: 3 ECTS

Generally, if you attend a course without taking the exam, you receive 3 ECTS credits. In some seminar you may need to do a small assignment in order to participate successfully and receive 3 ECTS (this may include a presentation (without a written out version), taking the minutes for a session etc.).

Successful participation in a seminar and graded exam: 5 ECTS

Normally, the exam is a short essay (8-10 pages). But it may also involve an oral examination, or presentation (including a written out version). You will have to discuss the kind of graded exam at the beginning of the course with your professor.

Completion of a whole module: full ECTS points assigned to the module

If you complete the seminars and exam of a whole module, you will get the full ECTS points that are assigned to the relevant module. For example, if you successfully participate 3 seminars in the BA module "Praktische Philosophie" or "Theoretische Philosophie" and write a final term paper (ca. 15 pp.) in one of the 3 seminars you will receive 12 ECTS points.
